



Integration with Badak LNG and Domestic Multi-Buyer Network



312 KM Pipeline Backbone



- 42" PECIKO pipeline spans approximately 312 kilometers.
- Connects upstream gas fields: PHM (SMK, PPA, Sisi Nobili, Tambora, Tunu) and PHSS.
- Critical gas corridor in East Kalimantan.



Integrated with PT Badak LNG

- Connected via Badak Export Manifold.
- Enables large-scale LNG processing and exports.
- Supports Indonesia's LNG export and domestic supply programs.



Domestic Multi-Buyer Access

- Gas channeled through KM53 Station to multiple domestic buyers.
- Key buyers: PGN, PLN, KPI, KPA, BME, SHB, DKT.
- Supports power generation, petrochemical, fertilizer, and utility sectors.


